

AKAPS Al Ramtha Reopening Guidelines For students

1. All students in Grade 7, 8 and 9 of AKAPS -Al Ramtha school will be tested for COVID-19 in advance of physically joining the school.
2. AKAPS is providing the physical distancing measures in designing the classroom layouts, canteen, GYM, corridors etc....
3. AKAPS will encourage paperless community and elevated the use of technology in the educational provision to minimize contacts.
4. Students need to wear suitable PPE throughout the duration of the school day.
5. Students below 6 years (below Grade 1) are not required to wear masks but they will wear face shield instead.
6. Students of Grade 1 and above, teachers and school staff members are required to bring a minimum of two (2) masks each to school per day, for their personal use.
7. Schools will hold an available stock of spare masks to supplement any student's or visitor's needs.
8. Sufficient stocks of masks, gloves and sanitizers are available and special designated bins to throw used items are available (as recommended by relevant governmental authorities).
9. Hand sanitizing stations are set up throughout the school premises, with clear instructions and signages. Students will be encouraged to wash their hands and

sanitize at regular intervals through the day. In particular, pre and post -lunch time.

- 10.Face shields are encouraged during meal breaks when masks need to be temporarily removed.
- 11.Students will be required to replace their masks following the lunch break.
- 12.Students are required to wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds before and after mealtimes.
- 13.Any student who is at-risk should stay at home and needs to submit medical certificate stating their medical condition.
- 14.Group activities such as school trips, celebrations, sports days, and student camps are canceled.
- 15.All students must download the Al Hosn App to ensure traceability in the event of infection.
