

AKAPS Al Ramtha Reopening Guidelines

For Parents

1. All students of AKAPS -Al Ramtha schools will be tested for COVID-19 in advance of physically joining the school.
2. The school is providing the physical distancing measures, and designing of the classroom layouts, canteen, GYM, corridors.....etc.
3. Students will be required to replace their masks following the lunch break.
4. Students with medical conditions are exempted from wearing a mask with a medical certificate only, and they should wear face shields instead.
5. Students will arrive and leave the school at the determined start and finish time. Schools may look to implement staggered start and finish times, based upon grade levels, to further reduce the risk of larger groups
6. Parents are not permitted to enter the school premises, but they can drop off/pick up their children in designated points.
7. Only one family member or a guardian is allowed to enter the school facility for drop-off and/or pick-up his/her child.
8. People with compromised medical conditions, including the elderly, should not come for drop-off and/or pick-up.
9. The temperature of each student, parents and staff members will be measured in the entrance points.
10. Individuals who are found to have a high temperature (starting from 37.5) will be taken aside and moved to the designated segregation zone for a second test by a handheld scanner. If needed, they will be moved to a isolation area to be processed as per the protocol.

11. The school will reschedule its transportation time timetable to ensure it is aligned with the reopening operational plan of the school.
12. The school will be using a paperless strategy and elevated use of technology in the educational provision to minimize contacts.
13. Encourage your kid/kids to bring healthy food from home while alerting them not to share it with others. Teachers should supervise to ensure that children do not share food.
14. Students must bring their own exclusive stationary items, devices or gadgets (i.e. laptops, tablets, headphones, etc.).
15. Student must not share their stationery. If the children need a supply of stationery, it should be done by the teacher via proper disinfection.
16. Students who travel must adhere to any UAE authority requirements, including any self-isolation and testing requirements
17. Appointments must be made in advance via the main reception for face to face meetings. These meetings must be planned after school hours when students have left the school premises
18. Any student who is at-risk needs to submit medical certificate stating their medical condition.
19. Group activities such as school trips, celebrations, sports days, and student camps are canceled.
20. All parents must download the Al Hosn App to ensure traceability in the event of infection.
